National Child Awareness Month

National Child Awareness Month (NCAM) began as a local effort led by Festival of Children Foundation (FOCF) and its founder Sandy Segerstrom Daniels to refocus the nation's attention on improving the lives of all children in America and shining a light on the charities that serve them. On July 31st, 2024 the United States Senate passed S.Res.792 by Unanimous Consent designating September 2024 as National Child Awareness Month for the 17th consecutive year.
